Family Endeavors, Inc. dba Endeavors® is a national provider of services in support of children, families, Veterans, and those struggling with mental illness. Our mission is to passionately serve vulnerable people in crisis through our innovative, personalized approach. Our vision is to restore dignity and improve the quality of life for the vulnerable people we serve through the benefits of our programs. To do so, Endeavors offers:

- **Veteran and Military Family Services.** Our Veterans Services program offers Homelessness Prevention & Stabilization Services to Veterans and their families in Texas. These supportive services include outreach, case management, help in obtaining VA benefits, emergency financial assistance for rent & utilities, and assistance in obtaining and coordinating other public benefits.
- **Mental Health Services.** Endeavors provides mental health services to Veterans, active duty military, and their family members through our Military Family Clinics (MFCs). Our MFCs in San Antonio, El Paso, and Killeen provides in house and tele-health mental services, psychiatric services, as well as life skill courses at no to low cost. In order to provide high-quality, accessible, and integrated mental health care to all Veterans and their families, our services are available regardless of role, discharge status, or ability to pay.
- **Community Services.** Our community services focus on families, seniors, children, and individuals who require case management, clinical services, and life-skills training. Through strategic community partnerships, we host financial literacy, parenting, employment, and marriage and relationship strengthening.
- **Housing Services.** We connect Veteran families and adults with mental disabilities to supportive housing, case management, professional counseling, life skills training, and employment opportunities.
- **Supportive Employment.** Our staffing services respond to emergency situations and health care setting needs by providing supportive employment opportunities to individuals with disabilities.
- **Disaster Relief.** We develop recovery plans, create safe environments, and provide resource referrals for anyone impacted by Presidentially Declared Disasters. Endeavors has the capacity and capability to deploy large amounts of staff in a short amount of time. In response to Presidentially Declared Disasters and emergency sheltering taskings.

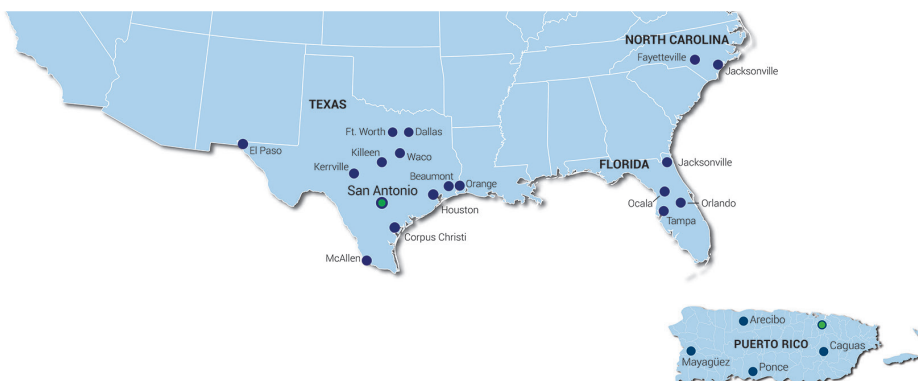
